Eleven day combo fly in & back –Start San Diego, February 8 – 18

Seven day combo fly into Loreto – Start in Loreto – February 9 - 15

2019 Day by day itinerary for 7 day Start In Loreto combo trip Feb 9 - 15	
Date	
Day one (Friday) February 9	Your arrival day in Loreto BCS. Our driver will meet you at the Loreto Airport and transport you directly to the El Dorado Hotel. Your guide will meet you at the hotel and discuss the plans for the next few days.
Day 2 – 3 -4 Feb 10-11-12	Each day you are scheduled for a blue whale boat trip leaving the dock at 8 and returning in the early afternoon after a great day of whale watching (B)
Day 5 February 13	After breakfast your group will drive south& across the Baja Peninsula to mag Bay and the Puerto Lopez mateos whale watching dock. You will do one gray whale watching boat trip here today (B)
Day 6 Feb14	Today you have two gray whale boat trips scheduled (B)
Day 7 February 15	Departure Day – We transport you from mag Bay back to Loreto and drop you off at the El Dorado Hotel ending your 7 day trip with us.

2019 Day by day itinerary for 8 day combo trip Feb 8 - 15

Day one (Friday) February 8	Our driver meets you at 7:00 a.m. at the Holiday Inn Bayside in San Diego. From there he drives you approximately 1 1/2 hours to the Ensenada Airport where you will meet your flight to Guerrero Negro. Day two February 9	Today we go on two gray whale watching boat rides at Laguna Ojo de Liebre. We always expect to have fun on every boat trip. Every trip seems different, but you can be assured that you will see hundreds of whales while out on your whale watching trip. But no trip to see the gray whales would be complete without a very close encounter with a friendly whale. We do not offer a guarantee that this will happen. But we have a perfect 20+ year record for close encounters for our five day and longer trips. We expect that you will have a great whale watching experience. (B, L, D)
Day 3 February 10	After breakfast your group will drive across the Baja Peninsula to the Sea of Cortez where you will stay in Loreto tonight at the El Dorado Hotel. (B)

Day 8 February 15	Departure Day – We transport you to the Guerrero Negro Airport to meet your flight to Ensenada. There our transporter will greet you and carry you across the border to the Holiday Inn – Bayside in San Diego arriving around 5:00 to 6:00 pm.

Day 11 February 18	Departure Day – We transport you to the Guerrero Negro Airport to meet your flight to Ensenada. There our transporter will greet you and carry you across the border to the Holiday Inn – Bayside in San Diego arriving around 5:00 to 6:00 pm.

Please read a few fine print notes below

* Until we have accepted reservations for a trip date we reserve the absolute right to change, cancel or alter trip dates and itineraries. Once we accept a deposit, we have never canceled or changed a date without the willing agreement of all group members. We do our best to adhere to our published itineraries on a day by day basis, but frequently we must switch segments of the tour because of weather, animals, political or other unscheduled situations.

** **We reserve the absolute right without limitation** or restriction to make changes to the trip itineraries. Changes are made to accommodate local conditions, weather, animal behavior, legal or political situations, road conditions or other normal or unexpected life situations. We try our best to maintain the same whale watching opportunities regardless of any changes we make. We seldom make major changes, but every year some minor changes are made.

*** We do not REQUIRE trip/travelers emergency insurance. However we **strongly urge** every guest to purchase adequate insurance to cover any possible unexpected or unplanned for events. **In the event you choose to not have travelers insurance for this trip, you will be asked to sign an additional waiver that simply says you were advised to get the insurance, but chose to not do so as you have the financial means readily available to handle any emergency.**

Some Misc. notes:

Flight delays and disruptions on the Ensenada/Guerrero Negro flight can occur due to weather or airline changes for any number of reasons. We have contingency plans for dealing with these unexpected situations although we hope to not ever need to use them. Upon sign up in your information packet will be comprehensive details of various alternative plans we have used in the past and will unfortunately probably need to use again in the future. Our goal with these plans is to get you to our camp safely, get you all of the whale watching as planned and to give you the best trip possible. Patience and an open attitude are guaranteed to make any unexpected situations less stressful for you and your fellow travelers.

Meals in Loreto on combo trip: We generally eat together as a group with individual meal checks. However frequently some travelers will choose to go off on their own for dinner. This is just one of several reasons the Loreto meals are excluded from the tour package. Loreto has some fine restaurants to enjoy. If you want a special anniversary or birthday dinner alone, Loreto is an excellent place for a romantic dinner evening.

Celebration at our camp: If you want a bottle of champagne or other special detail for a special celebration while at camp, please give us as much notice as possible. The supply chain is long and difficult once we open camp and already have the majority of our non-perishable supplies on site. Champagne, cake or other can be arranged. Yes, a nicely decorated personalized cake is possible with enough notice.
