

## Day 1

\*Below is a general outline of our Isla Coronado Skiff and Snorkel day tour itinerary. Please note that this is our ideal schedule; however it may be adjusted due to weather or other items outside our control. Your adventure consultants and guides will brief you with any updates prior to your departure.

### **7:30am Meet in the Hotel Lobby**

Meet your local Sea Kayak Adventures guide in the designated hotel lobby. *\*Please have breakfast on your own before meeting the group as it is not included in your itinerary.*

### **8:00 - 8:30 am Depart the Loreto Marina**

We leave the Loreto Marina by 8:30 am. Sit back, relax and take in the stunning views during the panga ride to Isla Coronado. The panga ride always presents a great opportunity for birding and marine life watching, often we'll see flying manta rays, dolphins and other marine mammals during our drive to the island.

### **9:30 - 10:00 am Arrive on Isla Coronado**

Once we arrive on the island we spend the morning snorkeling with colorful fish, relaxing on the sandy beaches, and taking an interpretive nature hike with your bilingual guide.

### **12:00 pm Lunch on the Beach**

When the sun is high overhead we stop for lunch on the beach, relishing the local fare that your guides prepare.

### **2:30 - 3:30 pm Snorkeling and Return to Loreto**

Following lunch we have more time to watch seabirds along the shore and soaring overhead, sea lions swimming and hauling themselves out on rocks and perhaps more snorkeling.

### **What to Bring:**

Note: Please dress appropriately for the day's weather and for being outside in the elements during your tour. Weather on the Gulf of Mexico can vary and change quickly, so dressing in layers is always a good practice. It's helpful as well if you wear your swimsuit under your clothes to start the day.

- Swimsuit (note, we'll provide the snorkeling equipment and wetsuits when

needed)

- Rash guard
- Waterbottle (guides will refill as needed)
- Sunglasses
- Sun protective clothing and hat
- Towel
- Chapstick
- Small day pack or hip pack with any personal items
- Light jacket or sweater
- Waterproof camera or waterproof phone case
- \*Please Note: On all tours that include snorkeling, we highly recommend that you bring a rash guard or set of synthetic long-sleeve top and full-length bottoms as small (non-toxic) jellyfish can be present in some areas.

Sea Kayak Adventures provides a mask, snorkel and fin for participants.
