Useful Information:

Vaccinations

Make sure to consult with your physician, which immunizations might be needed for Peru. We recommend immunizations for Hepatitis A & B and Typhoid. You might also consider a vaccination for the Yellow Fever and preventive pills for Malaria, if you are going to the rainforest or jungle. Travelers should be current on all other standard vaccinations. ALWAYS consult with a physician before you travel.

Tipping Policy

Tips are not included in the price, however, we want to clarify that tipping is not an obligation. Each passenger decides for themselves if, and how much, they want to tip.

Machu Picchu Visitor Guidelines: The INC (National Cultural Institute) has set out the following rules for all visitors to Machu Picchu.

- 1. Tourists will only be allowed to carry packs or small bags when visiting the site (less than 20 liters).
- 2. Drinks can only be taken in water containers, disposable plastic bottles are not permitted in the archeological monument District Municipality of Machu Picchu law Nr. 008-2008/MDM Nov 12, 2008.
- 3. Walking sticks or canes may only be carried by elderly or disabled people.
- 4. Climbing on Inca walls is not permitted.
- 5. Bonfires are not permitted.
- 6. Do not throw trash.
- 7. Bathrooms are outside of the ruins.
- 8. Preserve local flora and fauna.
- 9. Do not make noise, whistle or yell.
- 10. Professional photography or filming is only allowed with official authorization from the Cuzco Regional Cultural Organization.
- 11. We know that most of our visitors like to take pictures as a hobby and may carry professional equipment. In this case they are only allowed to carry standard lenses (17 50 mm or other lenses catalogued as standard).
- 12. It is permitted to walk around the signaled paths only, please do not enter the restricted areas.
- 13. Graffiti and writing on the walls or floors is forbidden.

Machu Picchu Train Guidelines:

- 1. All passengers must arrive at the station at least 30 minutes prior to departure.
- 2. Each passenger (traveling alone or in a group) must board the train showing their ticket and identification card (copy or original).
- 3. Each passenger may take one bag only according to the restrictions below:
